**We accept payment at the box office and kiosk bar by cash and debit card (and via HBPH gift voucher for tickets only). We do not accept payment by credit card.**

**ELEVENSES** are our weekday morning screenings, where the programme listing is for 10.30am & the feature begins at 11am. All tickets are £6.50 and include a free tea or coffee and a biscuit. **PARENT & BABY** screenings are monthly screenings **exclusively** for parents / carers and their babies aged under 12 months. Tickets are £6.50 and include a tea, coffee or glass of cordial for the grown up. Only adults with babies are admitted.

**THE BOX OFFICE** opens 15 minutes before the pre-film programme start time shown overleaf in SHOW TIMES (please note the programme starts 30 minutes before the feature), and one hour before the start time shown overleaf for Live Arts and events, marked \*. The Box Office remains open for 30 minutes after the film, Live Arts screening or event starts.

**THE CINEMA** opened in 1921 and is a 527 seat, single screen venue. It is operated by Hebden Royd Town Council on a not-for-profit basis for the community. We depend on our customers for support, so please buy your food and drink from our kiosk, share your planned visits and experiences on social media and bring your friends. You can also become a **Member**, join the **Friends of the Picture House** (it's free!) or **Sponsor a Seat** to further support us.

**ACCESS** We mainly use the Stalls area only which seats 299 and is accessible. Level access is via the Memorial Gardens side of the building – use a RADAR key to alert staff to your presence at the side door or call 01422 842807. Captioned screenings (CC) – subtitles on screen – and audio described films (AD) – the action described via a headset – are regular features of our programme – see SHOW TIMES.
